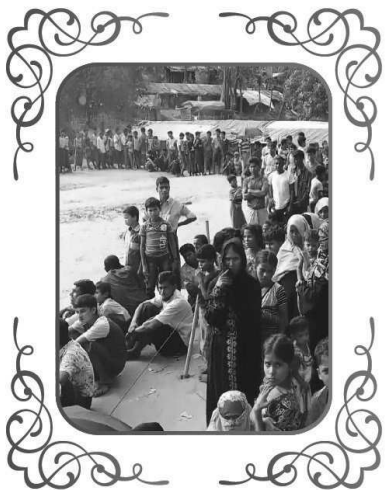
DAY 1
